



Position Announcement

Firefighter

(Position Code 230/231)

Approx. Annual Salary: CEP - \$51,309 and EMT - \$44,188

These are fulltime positions in the Operations Division. Attached to this announcement is a copy of the complete job description for the position, which includes the position requirements and qualifications.

Applications are available at Fire Station 401 (Administration) during normal business hours effective Monday, Sept. 18, 2017. Completed applications must be returned to Fire Station 401 (Administration) at or before 4:00 p.m. local time on Monday, Oct. 23, 2017.

Minimum Education, Training and Experience Requirements

1. Must be 18 year old.
2. Must possess a valid Arizona EMT-B or CEP Certification (or NREMT).
3. Must be an Arizona Certified Firefighter II (or IFSAC).
4. High School Diploma or GED equivalent.
5. Must possess a valid Arizona Drivers License.
6. No felony convictions or disqualifying criminal histories within the past ten (10) years.
7. Maintain a standard of physical fitness as established by the District and District Physician.

Selection Process:

1. Review of applications to determine minimum qualifications.
2. Orientation and Written Examination for all qualified applicants
3. Physical Ability Test (PAT) to demonstrate skills and abilities for the top 20 scoring candidates. Other candidates who pass the written test will be placed on a Contingency List ranked in order of the written test score. This list, or a portion thereof, will be activated should the current Eligibility List be exhausted within the validation period.
4. Oral interview (Review Board).
5. Establish Eligibility List
6. Background investigation
7. Medical examination including drug screen.

The above listed process is to determine whom the best-qualified candidate is to fill the current vacancies. It is the intent of the District to establish an eligibility list for hiring to fill future vacancies while that eligibility list is in effect. Eligibility Lists are valid for up to a one-year period or until depleted which ever comes first.

This notice is published by authority of the Fire Chief. Positions that may be currently vacant should be filled as soon as possible.
